Guided by the motto 'Dare to Know', we partner with organisations from around the world to showcase scientific excellence, promote debates on the world's major challenges, and find interactive and creative ways to make science, research and innovation engaging.

Our focus is on exchange and reflection: the programme is based on interactive and often interdisciplinary formats ranging from panel discussions, workshops, exhibitions, to VR-experiences, film screenings, music installations and much more.

AN INSPIRING FESTIVAL FOR SCIENCE AND SOCIETY

Berlin Science Week connects over 600 contributors and more than 20,000 participants in over 200 events.

Our audiences come from a multitude of social, economic, and national backgrounds. We reach scientists, researchers, academic institutions, NGOs, businesses, the press, and politicians, as well as the interested general public. The relevance of our programme is evidenced by the steady growth of our social media following (>25,000 subscribers), and by more than 250 articles in national and international press. During the Berlin Science Week, an average of 22,000 people from all over the world visit our website.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

We coordinate, curate, and communicate the programme to the media and the public, creating awareness and visibility. We facilitate networking opportunities, synergies and connections, and offer our expertise on science communication and event management.
