## Art & Science Programme

We're looking for applications to present works, projects, or events at the intersection of art and science that engage with this year's festival theme In Touch. Applications will be evaluated based on their artistic and scientific quality, their connection to the theme, the experience they offer visitors, and their feasibility within the Festival Centre.

We particularly welcome proposals that introduce underrepresented perspectives, experiment with formats, or open dialogue between disciplines and communities.

## Selection Criteria

<b>Artistic &amp; Scientific Quality</b>	Your proposal should show strength in both its artistic and scientific dimensions. We want to see that your work is grounded in genuine scientific inquiry and that its artistic approach is thoughtful and well-executed.
<b>Connection to the Festival Theme</b>	Show us how your work, project, or event connects to this year's festival theme. We're looking for proposals that go beyond surface-level references and engage with the theme in a way that opens new perspectives or invites reflection.
<b>Audience Experience</b>	Berlin Science Week brings together a curious, diverse public. We want to know: what will visitors take away from your event? The strongest proposals create experiences that are accessible, thought-provoking, and memorable.
<b>Feasibility</b>	Can your project be realistically implemented within the Festival Centre, with the available budget and resources? Proposals that are clear about their technical and logistical needs score higher here.
